#### ■ About the PRISMA Statement (2020)

Currently, when submitting a notification for a food product with function claims based on a systematic review (SR), it is necessary to adhere to the PRISMA Statement (Preferred Reporting Items for Systematic Reviews and Meta-analyses Statement), which is an international guideline for SR reporting. Since the inception of the Foods with Function Claims system, submissions have been required to comply with the "PRISMA Statement (2009)." However, with the update of the "PRISMA Statement (2009)" to the "PRISMA Statement (2020)," new notifications for food products with function claims from April 1, 2025, will now require SRs to be compliant with the "PRISMA Statement (2020)."

While this change does not alter the underlying research papers, it necessitates a more detailed evaluation of the quality of the scientific evidence and its compilation into SR materials.

"LycoLift™" was launched in 2018 as a water-soluble powder standardized to contain 0.5% or more of total lycoperosides, an ingredient for maintaining skin elasticity. Its mechanism of action has been patented, as detailed below:

We successfully isolated and identified lycoperosides, saponin components unique to tomato seeds. Focusing on the normalization of the extracellular matrix (ECM) cycle, it has been confirmed that "LycoLift™" promotes collagen production and simultaneously increases the number of lysosomes, which are responsible for the uptake and degradation of ECM waste products.
